Homeboy Industries provides hope, training, and support to formerly gang-involved and previously incarcerated men and women, allowing them to redirect their lives and become contributing members of our community.

#### THE IMPACT

Homeboy Industries began in 1988 and has evolved into the largest gang intervention, rehab and reentry program in the world. Each year we welcome nearly 9,000 people through our doors seeking to transform their lives. Our clients are embraced by a community of kinship and offered a variety of free wraparound services. In addition to serving over 7,700 community clients, our flagship 18 month re-entry program is offered to over 400 men and women each year. Approximately two-thirds of our senior staff are graduates of this program. We focus on healing and job training through our social enterprises so trainees can discover their true selves and live healthy lives, contributing to the wellbeing of their families and communities thereby breaking the cycle of intergenerational trauma that have plagued so many.
