Background

<u>Summary</u>

This position is responsible for supporting the daily operations of the Apparel Recycling division including but not limited to: receiving, sorting, depackaging, demanufacturing, reselling and shipping. Balances a positive and team oriented attitude with a healthy sense of urgency and accountability. Expected to gain and apply knowledge as the business grows and work closely with the Apparel Recycling management and team.

Responsibilities

- Quality, Environmental, Health & Safety (QEHS) Management System
 - Keep the warehouse and surrounding area secure, organized, free from hazards, and otherwise up to QEHS standards- including the correct use of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).
- Planning
 - Work closely with the Director of Reuse to execute Apparel Division action items both in the warehouse and in the office.
 - Implement action plan(s) assigned and ensure productivity expectations are met.
- Operations
 - Work with the Director of Reuse to research and optimize material disposition to different approved downstream vendors/buyers based on price, convenience, weight minimums, etc.
 - Review and audit shipping and receiving reports for accuracy.
 - Conduct and maintain an accurate inventory count of various merchandise throughout the warehouse.
 - Receive and document inbound and outbound loads and ensure accuracy of shipping logs.
 - Document and share newly acquired knowledge (especially resulting from unusual situations).
 - Any and all other tasks, projects, duties, and activities as assigned.

- Manage product listings across multiple marketplaces as well as physical stores.
- Maintain an online product catalog with accurate and well-written (proper spelling and grammar) descriptions based on product specifications.
- Perform quality assurance to ensure templates and links are functioning properly.
- Ensure that brand aesthetics are maintained across all sales and marketing channels.
- Make recommendations for changes to product listings based on market trends, opportunities, promotions, and competitor listings.
- Provide fast, responsive, and professional customer service via multiple channels, including email, chat, text, and phone.
- Maintain adequate supply of shipping materials, ensuring that products are securely packaged for shipment and that they ship on time (typically within 24 hours of sale).
