Mission

Homeboy Industries provides hope, training and support to formerly gang-involved and previously incarcerated individuals allowing them to redirect their lives and become contributing members of our community.

Impact

Homeboy Industries began in 1988 and has evolved into the largest gang intervention, rehab and reentry program in the world. Each year we welcome 10,000 people who come through our doors seeking to transform their lives. Our clients are embraced by a community of kinship and offered a variety of free wraparound services. Homeboy's flagship 18-month program is offered to over 450 individuals each year, and approximately two-thirds of our senior staff are graduates of this program. We focus on healing and job training through our 11 social enterprises so clients can discover their true selves and live healthy lives, contributing to the wellbeing of their families and communities, breaking the cycle of intergenerational trauma.



Our Social Enterprises

Homeboy Industries has grown from a single bakery to eleven social enterprises, which provide both a vital training ground for clients as well as revenue streams to support the mission. The expansion of our businesses proves that people can transcend their pasts and become valuable, empowered employees and business leaders.
